- Have weekly phone or instant message chats with each Governor.

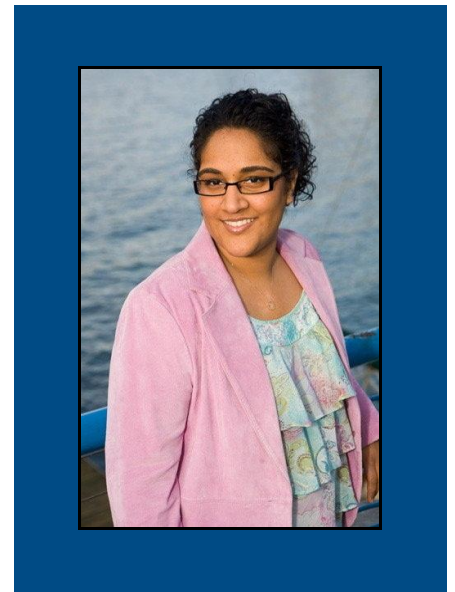
#### Promote Sub Region Service Initiatives
