- Our clubs will raise \$_____ for charities, for example the CKI service partners or district service projects.
- _____ members will be at international convention 201_.
- _____ clubs will be represented at district convention 201_.
- _____ members will be represented at divisional activities.

Overall, the goal of this format is to represent the districts within the goals set by the international board. In addition, to help the growth of the organization, this consistent format is a step to help accomplish this growth.
