

## CKI DUES STRUCTURE

All CKI Clubs are expected to pay annual dues to the International and District between October 1st and November 1st each year. These dues, which support the services provided to members, are based on the size of the host institution and the nation where the CKI club is located. Dues can be paid through the [Membership Update Center](#).

### International Fee Structure:

Below are the following International Club Fee clubs must pay depending on their size or country. These fees are paid annually starting October 1st.

Tiers Price Clubs in Tier A nations US\$24 per member (capped at US\$1,992 per club) Clubs in Tier B nations US\$10 per member (capped at US\$830 per club) Clubs in Tier C nations US\$5 per member (capped at US\$415 per club) District Dues Structure District Dues are set by a District's House of Delegates and approved by their Kiwanis District Board. District Dues cover the operations of the District Board and the District Budget. Important Deadlines October 1st: Dues Payment Begins December 1st: Dues Deadline February 1st: Unpaid Clubs are placed in Suspension Status September 30th: Unpaid Clubs are placed in Inactive Status 2-3 Years: Inactive Clubs will lose their charters

### Fees for New Charters:

Starting April 1, 2022, new CKI clubs will no longer be charged a 'chartering fee'. Instead, new clubs will pay the per-member international fee for every member on their roster along with their district dues, if applicable. To be chartered, the clubs must have the minimum number of members per club as described in the organization's governing documents.

As a part of this change, newly chartered clubs will receive a welcome kit that includes a letter from the CKI director, stickers, a charter document, member certificates, a recruitment brochure packet, recruitment posters, links to training videos, and a link to order other materials. Clubs wishing to purchase banners, bells, gavels, member pins and other materials may do so separately at the Kiwanis store.



### **Reactivation Fee Structure:**

A club that has not paid their international fees within a Kiwanis Fiscal Year, will be placed in Inactive Status. A club will need to pay a \$22\* Reactivation Fee, District Dues, and the International Fee for their club and submit a petition of reactivation in order to become a club in good standing. Please note, the reactivation fee can be petitioned to be waived by the International Board upon a written request to the International President and International Director outlining their reasoning.

\* Reactivation fee rate is only for the 2022-2023 year
