An Introduction to the City

Minneapolis was originally established as a city in 1867, but it merged with the former city of St. Anthony to form the presentday area in 1872. Its name comes from the Sioux word "minne" (water) and the Greek word "polis" (city). Minneapolis itself has a population of around 429,000, but the Twin Cities Metro Area (additionally encompassing both St. Paul and surrounding suburbs) has a total population of almost 3 million. The great Mississippi River actually flows through the middle of the city, and it once powered the many historic flour mills on its banks/is what gave Minneapolis the title of the "Flour Milling Capital of the World". Getting Around Minneapolis

While staying in Minneapolis, an important system to know is the Metro Transit system. This transportation system, comprised of buses and light rail trains, is fundamental to getting around in Minneapolis. There are two main train lines (blue and green), which help residents and visitors travel around the city (the light rail goes directly from the airport). Two other modes of transportation throughout the city are rideshare bikes (Nice Ride) and rental scooters (Bird, Spin, & Lime).

TWIN CITIES ATTRACTIONS

Minneapolis is a wonderful city with many amazing places to visit and see! Below are two lists with suggestions for such places, one relating to attractions accessible via the METRO Light Rail (Green/Blue Lines) and another to those near the hotel.

Near the Hotel

*All within a 30 minute walk from hotel

- Foshay Museum and Observation Deck
 A 360° view of downtown Minneapolis
- Target Field
 - Home of the Minnesota Twins
- Basilica of Saint Mary
 - America's first basilica made of stone and stain glass
- U.S. Bank Stadium
 - Stadium of the Minnesota Vikings
- Minneapolis Sculpture Garden and Walker Art Center
 - 11-acre park with 40+ sculptures and contemporary art center
- Minneapolis Institute of Art
 - Huge, 3-story museum of artworks free to the public
- Mill City Museum
 - Ruins of what was once the world's largest flour mill, near the picturesque Stone Arch Bridge
- Nicollet Mall
- Minneapolis Orchestra Hall
- Guthrie Theater

On the Metro Line

Green Line

- University of Minnesota
 - Public university with over 36,000+ students, settled on the Mississippi
 - Weisman Art Museum, Dinkytown
- Downtown Saint Paul
 - Historic downtown full of shops, museums, and restaurants
 - Union Depot, State Capitol, Science Museum, History Center, Xcel Energy Center, St Paul Cathedral
- Allianz Soccer Stadium
 - Home to the TC United, nestled in the Union Park, comprised of many novelty stores and nonprofits

Blue Line

- Mall of America
 - Massive shopping mall (520+ stores) with an indoor amusement park
- Minnehaha Park and Falls
 - City park with lush greenery, rolling hills and a waterfall
- Fort Snelling (former fortification site)
 - National historic landmark
